



Geo gets its name from the geometric shape of the glazed outdoor Vietnamese pot. Hand-crafted. Slight variations in size, shape, and color are to be expected. The raw, refined clay planters are glazed by pouring multiple layers of colors after the pots have been fired for a week at temperatures of almost 2,400 degrees Fahrenheit. Layered glazes will also demonstrate variation from the photos shown. Very durable and hardy, and are capable of year-round outdoor use in most climates, and 3-season outdoor use in cooler climates.



### PLANTER

- Geo is a freestanding piece.
- Manufactured in ceramic.
- Available with or without drain holes. Must specify on the purchase order.

### FINISHES

- Ceramic glaze - available in Aqua, Blue, Gunmetal, White, or Oil Black.

### MAINTENANCE

- Ceramic surfaces can be cleaned as needed using a soft cloth with warm water and a mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners. They have a natural finish that will weather gently over time with an attractive patina.
- Salt and calcium mineral buildup in your city water can create white spots on the glaze of the pots. These are easily cleaned by using vinegar; an S.O.S metal scrub pad can be used to clean persistent stains and does not harm the glaze or color of the pot.

### CARE TIPS

- Use lightweight potting soil (not top soil) when planting the clay fibre containers to avoid bulging.
- Lava or drainage rock or non-biodegradable foam packing peanuts should be used at the bottom of the planter to ensure proper drainage.
- Once planted up, take care not to push, pull or tug the clay fibre pots by the rim, this can cause them to break. The weight of soil and plant material is substantial.
